By Road
Turn off the A87, Inverness to Kyle of Lochalsh road, at Shiel Bridge and start your journey over the 2nd highest mountain pass in Britain. Stop off at the car park near the summit for a photo of the Five Sisters of Kintail then carry on over the top and down into Glenelg.

By Sea
Turn off the A87, Kyle of Lochalsh to Broadford road at the sign for Kyleerhea. The single track road twists and turns with the odd hidden summit until heading down toward the village and Glenelg-Skye Ferry jetty (10.00am to 6.00pm / 7.00pm seasonal)
